

Raised Air Intake Installation Instructions **Discovery II**

- Air Intake Cap

— Air Intake Pipe

- Gasket

Hose Clamp

- Flexible Hose

Rigid Pipe



The benefits of a raised air intake are to ensure a cleaner air supply in dusty or dirty conditons.







- 1) Remove the left front outer front wing panel by removing all screws along the top, the inside of the door, and around the headlamp assembly as shown above.
- 2) Disconnect the headlamp, turn indicator, and side lamps so that the fender may be completely removed.
- 3) First remove the plastic cowl from the inner wing by breaking off the two fixing bolts. Install the air intake pipe onto the vehicle, fitting it into the upper cavity of the inner wing so the vertical part of the pipe follows the windshield line. Attach the air intake pipe to the rain gutter as shown. Then attach the flexible hose, as shown above, to the rigid pipe using the supplied hose clamp. Feed the flexible hose through the existing hole in the wheelarch assembly. Fit the rigid pipe and attach into the air cleaner housing by using the sealant and 6mm bolts provided.





- 4) Use MANTEC's template as shown on page two to cut the fender hole. Be sure to thoroughly tape off the template to protect the paint around the hole. Make sure to first cut conservatively inside the trim line and fit several times until the fender is snug to the pipe with room for the supplied gasket.
- 5) To finish, attach the air intake cap with the mesh face directed toward the rear of the vehicle, and attach by using the self-tapping screws provided.


